Wraparound Policy

Matthew Arnold Primary is proud to offer a supportive, welcoming and inclusive environment that commits to providing the very highest standards in teaching, resources and guidance to allow every child to fulfil their potential.

We celebrate individuality and diversity, and deliver our curriculum in a range of engaging, experiential and varied ways to truly bring education and personal development to life and give all the children in our care the best possible start in life.

To support this ethos even further, we offer a range of After School Clubs which invite children to enhance their learning journey even further.

After School Clubs

We offer a range of after school clubs and activities, carefully planned to supplement and support the curriculum in fun and engaging ways.

The club rota is set on a half termly basis – clubs take place on set evenings and are sometimes for specific year groups. Available spaces at these clubs are limited, and we work very hard to make sure every child is given a fair opportunity to attend at least one of these clubs over the course of the school year if desired.

After School Clubs commence at the end of the school day – 3:20pm – and usually finish at 4:15pm, although this can vary depending on the age group and club in question.

As well as clubs run by our own staff, we also provide clubs run by LSSP (Liverpool School Sports Partnership) which are funded by the school budget

Details of the club or activity will be sent through TheSchoolApp, including the finish time when children will need to be collected by a parent/carer. These details will include a permission section to be authorised before the child(ren) may attend. Permission must be given for children to walk home alone.

In the rare event that a club has to be cancelled the school office will inform the parents/carers of all attendees, either by text message or by phone.

All school clubs are free of charge to all children – no payment is required.

Wraparound Childcare

We recognise that families may require additional wraparound support outside of our after-school activities. We use a third party, Dingle Kids Club Ltd, to provide an on-site breakfast and afterschool club.

Dingle Kids Club Ltd

Dingle Kids Club breakfast and afterschool clubs are Ofsted registered and based onsite in 'The Flat'. They offer a home from home setting with comfortable settees, TV and a wide range of toys and play equipment aiming to make the children as happy and comfortable as possible. Wraparound provision is available for children from ages 4-11 years old.

Breakfast club opens at 7.45am and children will be escorted to their class at the start of the school day.

After school club is open from the close of school until 5.55pm during term time. Children are provided with a light snack and refreshments throughout the session.
